

**Consent/Denial of Consent for  
Release of Student Directory Information to  
Military Recruiters or College/University Recruiters  
2022-2023**

Signed into law December 10, 2015, the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) is the federal legislation that governs elementary and secondary education in America. ESSA reauthorized the Elementary and Secondary Education Act and replaced No Child Left Behind (NCLB).

ESSA mandates that, upon request by a military recruiter, school districts provide access to all currently enrolled secondary school student's directory information except in instances when the student has "opted out" of release of directory information. Directory information means students' names, addresses and telephone numbers.

A secondary school student or the parent/legal guardian of the student may request that the student's directory information not be released to any military or post-secondary recruiter by signing and returning the exemption-from-disclosure form to the school designee. Students and parents/legal guardians may opt to withhold directory information by checking the box(es) below.
